1. General

The Covid Detection Foundation (“Virufy”, “we”, “us” or “our”) respects your privacy and is committed to processing your personal information in accordance with the law. This Cookie Policy (“Policy”) explains how Virufy uses cookies and similar technologies to process your personal information that you provide to us when you visit our website (www.virufy.org) (“Website”).

For the purposes of the Brazilian General Data Protection Law n° 13.709/2018, the European General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (the “GDPR”), and/or article 22 of the Law 24/2002 of Information Society Services and Electronic Commerce in Spain, Virufy is the “data controller” of, and responsible for, your personal information collected in accordance with this Cookie Policy. 2. What are Cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small pieces of data that are stored on your computer or mobile device whenever you access a website. They are used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website. Cookies enhance user experience by allowing websites to read and write them, enabling them to recognize visitors and remember important information that makes the visitor’s use of the website more convenient.

Cookies set by a website owner (in this case, Virufy) are called “first party cookies”. Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called “third party cookies”. Third party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the Website (e.g. analytics).

3. What Cookies do we use?

We may use the following types of Cookies to make the website user-friendly:

Essential Cookies:

The Website may use technical cookies to carry out activities that are strictly necessary for the operation or delivery of services. They include, for example, cookies that allow you to access secure areas of the website. We use this cookie to obtain the required consent to process data.

Preferences Cookies:

These cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like preferred language or the region that you are in.

Performance Cookies:

Also known as analytics cookies, these cookies may be used to collect information about your use of the Website and make the Website more user-friendly. Usage of analytic cookies includes

but is not limited to distinguishing users and understanding overall patterns of usage of the Website. We use this information in aggregate form to improve the way our Website works.

| _gat | Google Analytics | Used by Google Analytics to limit request rate. | 1 day | HTTP |
| _gid | Google Analytics | Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website. | 1 day | HTTP |
| _hjid | Hotjar | This cookie is set when the customer first lands on a page with the Hotjar script. It is used to persist the random user ID, unique to that site on the browser. This ensures that behavior in subsequent visits to the same site will be attributed to the same user ID. | 1 year | HTML |
| _hjIncludedInPageviewSample | Hotjar | This cookie is set to let Hotjar know whether that visitor is included in the data sampling defined by your site's pageview limit. | 30 minutes | HTML |
